TITLE:	Resolution Approving the Rejection Bids Received for City Owned Property Located at 11XX NW 1 Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311 – (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution rejecting bids for City owned property located at 11XX NW 1 Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311.

Background

The property located at 11XX NW 1 Avenue (Folio 494234038920), located in the Progresso Neighborhood is approximately 3,375 square feet (Exhibit 1). Meacham and Associates, performed an appraisal of the property and provided an "as-is" value of \$26,000. On March 3, 2020, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 20-37 declaring the property as no longer needed for public use and available for purchase, setting the minimum bid offer at \$26,000 (Exhibit 2).

On April 7, 2020, the City Commission amended Resolution 20-37 extending the bid deadline to May 15, 2020, due to the Safer At Home Regulations created in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. The City received one bid from Tom Smith Development, Inc for \$15,000 (Exhibit 3). Resolution 20-37 states that the City Commission shall not accept offers to purchase the property for less than 100% of the appraised value. As such, the City rejects all bids for property located at 11XX NW 1 Avenue.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal year impact associated with this action.
