Understanding with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to Access the Driver License and Motor Vehicle Database -

(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to access the driver license and vehicle database in order to issue parking citations.

Background

The Transportation and Mobility Department's Parking Services Division requires registered vehicle owner information, including addresses, to issue and collect parking citation fines as allowed by Florida Statutes.

This MOU will allow the City to connect to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles database in order to obtain this information. The City has historically completed a MOU for this purpose and wishes to continue obtaining this service. By executing this MOU, the City agrees to maintain the confidential and exempt status of any and all information provided by the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
