

RESOLUTION NO. 20-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES FOR ACCESS TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES' DRIVER LICENSE AND MOTOR VEHICLE DATABASE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Transportation and Mobility Department's Parking Services Division requires electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' driver license and motor vehicle database in order to obtain information to issue parking citations and collect fines; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") and the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, will allow the City to obtain the necessary information from the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' database; and

WHEREAS, the City has historically completed a MOU for this purpose and wishes to continue obtaining information from the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to access the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' driver license and motor vehicle database on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.

SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That if any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
