TITLE: Public Hearing and Adoption of Resolution Approving the First Amendment

to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Community Shuttle

Service - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Community Shuttle Service, in substantially the form attached, and authorizing the City Manager to execute the First Amendment, attached in Exhibit 1.

Background

On October 2, 2019 the City Commission approved an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for Community Shuttle Service with Broward County attached hereto as Exhibit 2. The ILA includes the terms and conditions for providing Community Shuttle Service within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City. The Community Shuttle Service is funded by the County.

Earlier this year, City and County staff met to clarify issues related to the Community Shuttle Service. This resulting First Amendment modifies Exhibit "A" to be consistent with the terms of the Agreement by:

- 1. Eliminating fares for the Beach Link and Las Olas Link routes;
- 2. Removing advertising on vehicles used in providing the service; and
- 3. Designating specific locations for Community Shuttle Service stops.

Once approved by the City Commission, these changes are effective August 19, 2020.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.
