Extension and Increase in Funding - \$27,777 - (Commission Districts 1, 2,

3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant extension and additional funding in the amount of \$27,777 from the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ).

Background

In January 2015, the City submitted an application to the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to deliver services that address the issue of overrepresentation of minority youth in Florida's juvenile justice system. The City was awarded grant funding in order to address Disproportionate Minority Contact (DMC) thru the provision of DMC curriculum training, focus groups, and DMC analysis reports for the 2015/2016 fiscal year. Pleased with the success of this program as administered by the Fort Lauderdale Police Department, DJJ continued to renew the contract for three more years, ending on August 31, 2019. Due to the continued success of the program, DJJ awarded the City a new contract in the amount of \$27,777 for the FY2019/2020. DJJ now seeks to extend the contract by another 12 months and to increase the total grant award to \$55,554, so that additional DMC trainings, focus groups, and analysis reports can be provided. The revised grant period wound extend from September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021.

Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$27,777. The grant does not require matching funds. Funding is contingent upon the approval of consolidated budget CAM 20-0092.
