TITLE: Motion Approving Increase in Funds for Web Uniform & Equipment Purchasing Program from Galls, LLC – \$240,000– (**Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4**)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds for the Web Uniform & Equipment Purchasing Program from Galls, LLC, in the amount of \$240,000.

Background

On February 18, 2020, the City Commission approved a contract for Web Uniform & Equipment Purchasing Program from Galls, LLC (CAM 20-0046) in the amount of \$130,000, via Broward Sheriff's Office Contract No. 14036AG to be utilized by the Fire Rescue Department.

By utilizing this contract, the Police Department can more efficiently and effectively control the quartermaster function of the department's Police Supply. Utilizing Galls' E-quip inventory function will help automate inventory management of numerous uniform and equipment needs of both sworn police officers and Public Service Aides.

At the time of the original approval, the request did not include Police's anticipated usage. The Police Department is seeking City Commission approval of funds in the amount of \$240,000 for a total annual contract value of \$370,000.

Resource Impact

There will be a FY20 fiscal impact in the amount of \$40,000. Future expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
