

RESOLUTION NO. 20-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 20-45, WHICH WAIVED THE NORMAL PROCEDURES AND FORMALITIES REGARDING CERTAIN ACTIVITIES AND DELEGATED TO THE CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE CERTAIN EMERGENCY AUTHORITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 20-45, which waived the normal procedures and formalities regarding certain activities and delegated to the City Manager or the City Manager's designee certain emergency authority related to Governor Ron DeSantis's Executive Order Number 20-52 declaring a state of emergency as a result of Novel Coronavirus Disease 19; and


WHEREAS, such waiver of normal procedures and formalities and delegation of emergency authority are no longer needed;

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 20-45 of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is hereby rescinded.
