

RESOLUTION NO. 20-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT AND AN ESCROW AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT AND ESCROW AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UNDER PROJECT FM NUMBER 440072-1-52-01 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,698.40 TO INSTALL DECORATIVE PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING ALONG PORTIONS OF STATE ROAD A1A, SOUTHEAST 17TH STREET, AND SEABREEZE BOULEVARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") is planning on installing new pedestrian lighting along portions of State Road A1A, SE 17th Street, and Seabreeze Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes for the FDOT to install new pedestrian lighting that will aesthetically match the existing decorative conditions along State Road A1A, SE 17th Street, and Seabreeze Blvd.; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to provide financial assistance to FDOT to install decorative pedestrian lighting in the amount of forty thousand six hundred and ninety-eight dollars and forty cents (\$40,698.40), in order for the lighting to aesthetically match the existing conditions along the roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Locally Funded Agreement in the amount of \$40,698.40 for the installation of decorative pedestrian lighting and the Escrow Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation are hereby approved.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Locally Funded Agreement in the amount of \$40,698.40 for the installation of decorative pedestrian lighting for portions of State Road A1A, SE 17th Street, and Seabreeze Boulevard under FM No. 440072-1-52-01 and is authorized to execute the Escrow Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
