TITLE:	Resolution Approving a Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration for the Runway Incursion Mitigation Project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport - (Commission District 1)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a grant agreement accepting the anticipated grant funding of \$1,136,360 or 100% of the costs for the construction of the Runway Incursion Mitigation (RIM) project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), and authorizing the City Manager to execute a Grant Agreement, contingent upon review by the City Attorney, on behalf of the City.

Background

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) developed a comprehensive and multi-year program to identify, prioritize, and implement solutions to mitigate runway incursions. Five locations were identified by the FAA and Airport staff as areas of concern that could potentially lead to runway incursions as identified in FXE's updated Airport Layout Plan. (Exhibit 1)

The project will involve installing in-pavement and elevated LED Runway Guard Light (RGL) units as well as installation of new conduit and cabling. The installation of both inpavement and elevated RGL units will enhance FXE's ability to minimize and/or eliminate runway incursions and improve the overall operational safety of the Airport. The design was completed by HDR Engineering, Inc., the Airport's engineering consultant firm.

The FAA has agreed to provide grant funding of \$1,136,360 for 100% reimbursement of eligible construction costs for this project. To expedite the execution of the grant agreement, Airport staff is requesting to appropriate the anticipated grant funds and accept the grant contingent upon the City Attorney's review prior to execution of the agreement. If the grant is not awarded, the related expenditures will be charged to the Airport Fund.

Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City for the grant in the amount of \$1,136,360, contingent upon approval and appropriation of the October 6, 2020 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #20-0685.
