TITLE: Resolution Approving the Performing Arts Center Authority Budget and

Tri-Party Grant Agreement for Fiscal Year 2021 - (Commission District

2)

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the budget of the Performing Arts Center Authority ("PACA") for Fiscal Year 2021 ("FY2021") and authorize the execution of a Tri-Party Grant Agreement, in substantially the form attached, related to funding of the Performing Arts Center.

# **Background**

In accordance with its enabling act, Chapter 2005-335 Laws of Florida, PACA has presented its adopted budget for FY2021 (Exhibit 2) to the City Commission for approval. The City and County agree to provide financial assistance to PACA as accounted for in the budget under other local grants. Staff requests that the City Commission approve a Tri-Party Grant Agreement with PACA and Broward County governing the provision of this funding.

The City's responsibility under the agreement includes a cash contribution from the net garage revenues of the Arts & Science District Parking Garage to be remitted monthly in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 annually. The City agrees to provide in-kind landscape maintenance services having a value of at least \$30,000 annually, as well as reimburse PACA for any expenses paid for waste removal performed during the contract term in an amount not to exceed \$24,000. The agreement provides the method of payment and other details necessary to implement the terms of the agreement which covers the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

### **Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact for Fiscal Year 2020.
