

RESOLUTION NO. 20-143

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR HURRICANE DORIAN, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FUNDS AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security ("USDHS") has awarded the State of Florida funds to reimburse municipalities for Hurricane Dorian expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Hurricane Dorian Project is expected to be funded by FEMA (75%), the State of Florida (12.5%) and the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City") (12.5%); and

WHEREAS, the City expects to submit a claim estimated to be \$154,393.00 to FEMA for Hurricane Dorian; and

WHEREAS, the City estimates it will receive \$115,795.00 in Federal funds from FEMA and \$19,299.00 from the State of Florida and the City is expected to bear its share of the costs in the amount of \$19,299.00; and

WHEREAS, the amount of total grant funding and recovery amounts are contingent upon the USDHS and State of Florida's review and appropriation of each individual project worksheet or obligation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The Grant Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management for grant funds related to Hurricane Dorian is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$115,795.00 in Federal funds from FEMA and up to \$19,299.00 from the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale and the City Manager is authorized to execute any documents necessary for the acceptance of grant funds on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. The Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by proper City officials.

SECTION 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
