


# Conceptual Artwork Design Proposal Andrews Avenue Bridge




#### <u>Conceptual Artwork Design Proposal</u> <u>Andrews Avenue Bridge</u>

- The proposed artwork will illuminate and add visual interest to the piers and portions of the underside of the bridge.
- The pedestrian area under the bridge will be lit during the day and at night.
- Lights will be programed to change color each season, and to mark holidays or special events.
- Perforations in the backlit metal grills will create a design with abstract visual references to seashells.
- Artist Selection Panel included a City of Fort Lauderdale representative, a member of the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Civic Association, a member of Broward County's Public Art & Design Committee, an arts professional, and a Broward County Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division representative.


#### CONCEPTUAL DESIGN PROPOSAL WEST ELEVATION







### CONCEPTUAL DESIGN PROPOSAL DAYTIME



#### **METAL GRILLS**



The proposed material for this artwork is weathering steel. It is maintenance free and sustainable. The patterning is laser cut from 0.375" or 0.5" plate. Each pier carries its own pattern grill, on both sides, unless noted, suggesting shells, waves and abstract natural forms. At night the pattern grills are backlit, top-down, with programmable LED lighting.
