## RESOLUTION NO. 20-171

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY EXECUTE A FOURTEENTH MANAGER TO LANDSCAPE **AMENDMENT** TO THE INCLUSIVE MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF STATE NORTH OCEAN BOULEVARD. FROM ROAD A1A, ALHAMBRA SEABREEZE BOULEVARD TO STREET. PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City") and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") entered into the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement ("MMOA") on January 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a Fourteenth (14<sup>th</sup>) Amendment to the MMOA with FDOT for installation and maintenance of landscape improvements within the right-of-way on State Road A1A (North Ocean Boulevard), from Mile Post 2.637 (Seabreeze Boulevard) to Mile Post 2.441 (Alhambra Street); and

WHEREAS, the landscape improvements will be installed in accordance with the plans and specifications attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" of the MMOA; and

WHEREAS, because State Road A1A is an FDOT right-of-way, authorization for this work must be permitted by FDOT; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires municipalities to enter into a Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for the maintenance of landscape improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is hereby authorized to execute the Fourteenth (14<sup>th</sup>) Amendment to the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and the Florida Department of Transportation for the installation and maintenance of landscape improvements within the right-of-way on State Road A1A (North Ocean Boulevard), from Mile Post 2.637 (Seabreeze Boulevard) to Mile Post 2.441 (Alhambra Road).

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
