

RESOLUTION NO. 20-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SUBAWARD AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR CARES ACT FUNDING, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, RESCISSION OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTION PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has qualified for certain funding under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), a portion of which Broward County wishes to subaward to the City of Fort Lauderdale pursuant to a Subaward Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for CARES Act Funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale has been identified as an eligible local government that has incurred costs due to the COVID-19 public health emergency that are eligible for reimbursement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. A Subaward Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for CARES Act Funding ("Agreement") is approved in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #20-0845, and the City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments contemplated in Section 4.2 of the Agreement.

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
