TITLE: Motion Approving Negotiated Fee Schedule and Agreements for General

Environmental Engineering Consulting Services- Wood Environment and Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. and Langan Engineering and Environmental

Services, Inc. - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

## Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the ranking of firms and award a two-year renewable agreement, in substantially the form attached, for General Environmental Engineering Consulting Services, agreements with the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> ranked firms: Wood Environment and Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. and Langan Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc. in the estimated aggregate, two-year amount of \$400,000. Staff also requests approval for the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options contingent upon appropriation of funds.

## **Background**

On September 1, 2020, the City Commission approved CAM #20-0480 to award continuing contracts in the amount of \$300,000 to the top four consultants: E Sciences, Inc., Terracon Consultants, Inc., GHD Services, Inc., and Gallagher Bassett Services, Inc., for General Environmental Engineering Consulting Services. The approval also allowed staff to return to the commission at a later date to award agreements with the 5th and 6th ranked firms, Wood Environment and Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., and Langan Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc., after each respective negotiation was completed.

Staff has completed all negotiations and is requesting approval to award agreements with the 5<sup>th</sup> ranked firm, Wood Environment and Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. and 6<sup>th</sup> ranked firm, Langan Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc., for the General Environmental Engineering Consulting Services agreement. The cumulative amount totals \$700,000 and will be distributed among the six consultant agreements and will follow the normal task order process.

#### **Resource Impact**
