- TITLE: Motion Approving a Dock Use Agreement with Yachting Promotions, Inc. and the Marine Industries Association of South Florida, Inc. for the 2020 Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show for Use of Dockage at Las Olas Marina - (Commission Districts 2 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing execution of an agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Yachting Promotions, Inc. (YPI) and Marine Industries Association of South Florida, Inc. (MIA) for use of dockage at Las Olas Marina – for the 2020 Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show, October 28, 2020 through November 1, 2020.

Background

The agreement will authorize YPI and MIA to occupy all the available dock slips and docks at the Las Olas Marina to accommodate vessels for public exhibition participating in the 2020 Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show from October 28, 2020 through November 1, 2020. Proposed agreement requires breakdown of all event-related equipment, fencing temporary dockage, pilings, and removal of exhibitor's vessels no later than November 2, 2020. In addition, time of possession and surrender is based upon check-in and check-out policies for recording new arrivals and departures (October 28, 2020 through November 1, 2020).

YPI and MIA will pay a combined dockage fee for the use of the marina in the amount of \$68,564.04 which is based on the current 2020-2021 winter rate schedule, plus State Submerged Sovereign lease fees of \$4,113.84, and applicable sales taxes in the amount of \$5,402.45. YPI and MIA will be billed separately an advance deposit for the use of electricity in the amount of \$4,500. The determination of actual usage shall be on current Florida Power and Light (FPL) rates and will be invoiced to YPI and MIA by the City and payable within ten (10) business days. The agreement requires the City be named as an additional insured for commercial general liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$10,000,000.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal resource to the City in the amount of \$68,564.04 to be deposited into Fund 001, PKR090105-K186, \$4,113.84 to be deposited into Fund 001, PKR 090105-K191 and \$5,402.45 to be deposited into FD001, 219-45009 and is reflected in the FY 2021 Budget.
