#### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve event agreements, requests for road closures with The Heartbeat Foundation Corp. and WildSide Foundation, Inc., and authorize execution of the agreements by the City Manager.

## **Background**

City staff has been working closely with event organizers regarding event topics, such as logistics, maintenance, and security as described within. The Police Department recommends approval of the closing of the City streets, where appropriate. Staff concludes event parking has been satisfactorily arranged. Amplified music was discussed with event organizers and staff advised of the noise ordinance and possible concerns.

Event organizers will pay for all event costs and submit required certificates of insurance. Event organizers will also secure all other necessary permits and licenses required from other agencies. Civic and merchant associations have been notified, as appropriate, regarding events in their respective areas. Specific event details are included in each event application, as attached.

Where applicable, and upon fulfillment of all requirements, the City Commission authorizes amplified music for the events listed below.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreements is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.

All event promoters are aware of Broward County Ordinance 20-23, relating to special events. All promoters have submitted their operational plans to Broward County and are awaiting approval. Event approval is contingent on COVID 19 restrictions being lifted and/or written approval to host the event from Broward

# County.
