A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND FORT LAUDERDALE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LODGE NO. 31. INC., FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2020 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, REGARDING THE POLICE OFFICERS AND SERGEANTS COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT AS DEFINED IN FLORIDA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RELATIONS COMMISSION CERTIFICATION NUMBER 619 OF SEPTEMBER 27, 1983.

That the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 31 - Police Officers and Sergeants, for the period October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2022, is approved and ratified in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memo No. 20-0792, and the City Commission authorizes execution of the collective bargaining agreement.
