**TITLE**: Motion Approving Amendment No. 1 in the Amount of \$1,200,000 to Waste

Management Inc. of Florida for Increase in Funds for Recyclable Materials

Processing – (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve Amendment No. 1, in substantially the form attached, for an increase in funds to proprietary contract No. 12225-897, for recyclable materials processing services with Waste Management Inc. of Florida in the amount of \$1,200,000.

# **Background**

On May 7, 2019, the City Commission approved a contract for recyclable materials processing services with Waste Management Inc. of Florida in the amount of \$1,200,000 (CAM 19-0476).

Described contract is a two-year agreement with two, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds. The contract is in the first term, which expires on January 31, 2021.

Due to decreases in the market value of recyclable materials and increases in volumes collected since the initial approval of the contract, the Public Works Department is requesting an additional \$1,200,000 to increase the contract value to \$2,400,000.

### Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$1,200,000 in FY 2021. Funds for this purchase are available in the FY 2021 budget in the below listed accounts.
