## **RESOLUTION NO. 20-141**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF BROWARD COUNTY POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHEAST 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET, SOUTHEAST 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND SOUTHEAST 12<sup>TH</sup> STREET, AT SOUTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY, IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division ("BCTED") has recommended that a "No Thru Trucks" sign be posted at the intersections of Southeast 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Southeast 9<sup>th</sup> Street, and Southeast 12<sup>th</sup> Street, at South Federal Highway; and

WHEREAS, in response to Rio Vista Civic Association concerns, City staff and BCTED conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on Southeast 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Southeast 9<sup>th</sup> Street, and Southeast 12<sup>th</sup> Street, east of South Federal Highway, to access Cordova Road and Southeast 17<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, Southeast 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Southeast 9<sup>th</sup> Street, and Southeast 12<sup>th</sup> Street, east of South Federal Highway, are residential areas and are not suitable for commercial truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, a formal resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is required by Broward County in order for the new signage to be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE. FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby supports the installation of "No Thru Trucks" signage at the intersection of Southeast 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Southeast 9<sup>th</sup> Street, and Southeast 12<sup>th</sup> Street, at South Federal Highway, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in order to enhance public safety in that residential area.
