TITLE: Resolution Approving a Fiscal Year 2021 Not-For-Profit Grant Participation

Agreement with United Way of Broward County, Inc., for Homelessness -

\$710,000 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2021 Not-For-Profit Grant Participation Agreement with United Way of Broward County, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, and authorizing execution of the agreement.

Background

With the adoption of the FY 2021 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community, while making a positive impact. The benefiting not-for-profit organization is required to execute a participation agreement that provides for amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

United Way of Broward County, Inc. works with partner organizations to develop and implement solutions, resources, and strategies to address homeless concerns within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Lauderdale. United Way of Broward County is a recognized organization that supports the health, education, and financial stability members of our community. The proposed funding will be used to prevent and mitigate homelessness within the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$710,000 in FY 2021. Funding is budgeted and available per the table on the following page.
