**TITLE:** Resolution Amending Resolution 20-141 Revising the Language in Support of the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division posting “NO THRU TRUCKS” signage at the intersections of SE 7th Street, SE 9th Street, and SE 12th Street at South Federal Highway - **(Commission District 4)**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a Resolution amending Resolution 20-141 to revise the language in support of the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) posting “NO THRU TRUCKS” signage at the intersections of SE 7th Street, SE 9th Street, and SE 12th Street at South Federal Highway within the public right of way.

**Background**

On September 1, 2020, the City Commission approved Resolution 20-141, authorized through Commission Agenda Memo #20-0533 supporting the installation of “No Thru Trucks” signage along South Federal Highway at specific intersections along the eastern right of way line. BCTED requires a formal resolution of support from the City Commission for the new signage to be installed, per the existing Traffic Engineering Agreement.

A revision to the resolution is required to reflect that the City of Fort Lauderdale staff, instead of the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division, conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on SE 7th Street, SE 9th Street, and SE 12th Street, east of South Federal Highway, to access Cordova Road and SE 17<sup>th</sup> Street.
