TITLE: Second Reading - Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. C-18-46 of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to Provide that the Mayor and City Commissioners Elected in Regular Municipal Elections Shall Take Office on the First Regular Meeting Day in December Following Their Election - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt, on second reading, an Ordinance amending Ordinance No. C-18-46, to provide that the mayor and city commissioners elected in regular municipal elections shall take office on the first regular meeting day in December following their election.

Background

At the November 17, 2020, Conference Meeting, the City Commission discussed commencing the term of the next City Commission on December 2, 2020, rather than on January 5, 2021. The proposed ordinance would provide for the seating of City Commissions on the first regular meeting day in December following regular municipal elections in November.
