

RESOLUTION NO. 20-241

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 20-141, ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2020, BY REVISING LANGUAGE IN SUPPORT OF BROWARD COUNTY POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHEAST 7TH STREET, SOUTHEAST 9TH STREET AND SOUTHEAST 12TH STREET, AT SOUTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY, IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2020, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 20-141 in support of Broward County posting "No Thru Trucks" signage at the intersection of Southeast 7th Street, Southeast 9th Street and Southeast 12th Street, at South Federal Highway, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida; and

WHEREAS, a revision is required to reflect that the City of Fort Lauderdale staff, instead of the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division ("BCTED"), conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on Southeast 7th Street, Southeast 9th Street, and Southeast 12th Street, East of South Federal Highway, to access Cordova Road and Southeast 17th Street;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the second paragraph of the preamble of Resolution No. 20-141 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

WHEREAS, in response to Rio Vista Civic Association concerns, City of Fort Lauderdale staff conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on Southeast 7th Street, Southeast 9th Street, and Southeast 12th Street, east of South Federal Highway, to access Cordova Road and Southeast 17th Street; and

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
