

RESOLUTION NO. 20-242

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FY 2021 NOT FOR PROFIT GRANT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH UNITED WAY OF BROWARD COUNTY, INC., AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE GRANT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the mission of United Way of Broward County, Inc., is to unite the community to tackle the most complex, critical challenges and create long-lasting positive change, stand up for those who can't stand up for themselves, confront those who are working hard and falling short, and fight for the health, education, and financial stability of every person in the community; and

WHEREAS, United Way of Broward County, Inc., finds solutions and strategies to help homeless people within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, providing funds to United Way of Broward County, Inc., to help homeless people within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Lauderdale will enhance the public health, safety, and welfare, and thereby serve a legitimate public and municipal purpose;

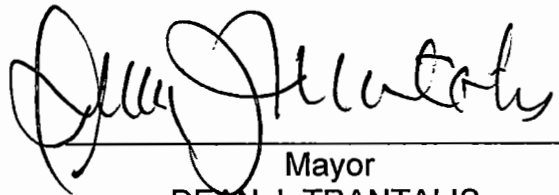
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission approves a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2021 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with United Way of Broward County, Inc., in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memorandum 20-0909, and authorizes execution of the Grant Participation Agreement.

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
