RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF BROWARD COUNTY POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE AT NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND NORTHWEST 15TH AVENUE BETWEEN COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD AND PROSPECT ROAD IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in response to the Twin Lakes residential community traffic safety concerns, the City of Fort Lauderdale staff conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on Northwest 15th Avenue, southbound from Commercial Boulevard and northbound from Prospect Road; and

WHEREAS, Northwest 15th Avenue, north of Prospect Road, is a residential roadway and is not suitable for commercial truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Northwest 15th Avenue, south of Commercial Boulevard, is a residential roadway and is not suitable for commercial truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, the installation of "NO THRU TRUCKS" signage will enhance public safety in the Twin Lakes residential community; and

WHEREAS, a formal resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is required by Broward County for the new signage to be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby supports the installation of "No Thru Trucks" signage at northbound and southbound Northwest 15th Avenue between Commercial Boulevard and Prospect Road in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in order to enhance public safety in the Twin Lakes residential community.
