**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a dock permit, for use by private persons of public property, for Steven & Judith Altman at 1028 SE 13<sup>th</sup> Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, FL.

**Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the installation, use, maintenance and repair of a proposed marginal dock, floating dock, and boatlift adjacent to 1028 SE 13<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Per Resolution 19-205, the \$1500 fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by private persons of public is waived for property owners whose seawalls were removed by the City due to the seawall construction project on Cordova Road (see Exhibit 3).

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval (10:0) of the application (see Exhibit 4).

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.
