

RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A USE AND OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A DOG RECREATIONAL AREA WITHIN RIVERSIDE PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE USE AND OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT AND THE ANNUAL USE AGREEMENT COMPLIANCE FORM DURING THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Fort Lauderdale residents have expressed the desire to use the open space on the west side of the Riverside Park neighborhood as a dog friendly recreational area; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has agreed to lease the right of way to the City of Fort Lauderdale, at no cost, for the public purpose of a temporary dog friendly recreational area; and

WHEREAS, the leased spaced is located west of SW 20th Avenue between SW 2nd Street and SW 4th Street; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires any use of airspace above or below the established grade line within the approved right of way limits on a Federal Aid System, to be accomplished pursuant to a Right of Way Use and Occupancy Agreement and an Annual Use Agreement Compliance form during the term of the Use and Occupancy Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby approves the Use and Occupancy Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for a dog recreational area within Riverside Park and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Use and Occupancy Agreement and an Annual Use Agreement Compliance form during the term of the Use and Occupancy Agreement.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
