TITLE:	United Way of Broward County, Inc., Overview of Homelessness Efforts for FY 2020 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

In FY 2020, the City Commission entered into a participation agreement with United Way of Broward County, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$750,000 to fund solutions and strategies to address homelessness. During the fiscal year, the City reimbursed the United Way for \$476,347.21 in eligible expenditures for services provided to individuals experiencing homelessness in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Staff from United Way of Broward County, Inc., will be presenting an update on the services delivered using City funds in FY 2020 and the associated outcomes. A summary report of services provided is included as Exhibit 1.

The City Commission approved funding in the amount of \$710,000 in FY 2021 to continue the work that began in FY 2019. In addition, Hope South Florida, Inc., was awarded \$40,000 directly to pay for case management services in FY 2021.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
