TITLE: Preliminary Schematic Design for the New Fort Lauderdale Police

Headquarters - (Commission District 2)

The new Police Headquarters approved by City of Fort Lauderdale voters on March 20, 2019 is currently in the schematic design phase. On August 18, 2020, AECOM was the selected firm to provide the overall project design, construction administration and management for the site. As part of their work AECOM has prepared a presentation of the exterior massing/form of the new building and the site plan indicating the location of the building footprint with parking structure and circulation.

The project consists of a three-story, 187,000 square foot police headquarters building which includes a community meeting space along with a three-story parking structure for 400 parking spaces. It is located on the east side of the current police headquarters building at 1300 West Broward Boulevard.
