Ms. Logan reviewed the staff report and concluded with:

In accordance with Section 47-24.11.C of the ULDR, staff finds that the application (for Archaeological Site Designation of Rivermont located at 1016 Waverly Road under case number UDP-HPD20004 meets criterion (a) as outlined in Section 47-24.11.C.7 of the ULDR.

Robert Carr, author of the designation report, stated this was one of the few preserved Tequesta (sites in Broward County. This was an important asset for the community and for the State.)

Ms. Logan confirmed that the City would seek the site's inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places. Local designation would provide additional protection for the site; the City would review any redevelopment proposed for the site, including the park. Mr. Carr concurred that the national recognition provided only limited protection, so local designation was more important to protect the site.

Chair Blank opened the public input portion of the meeting. There being no members of the public wishing to address the Board on this item, Chair Blank closed the public input portion of the meeting.

Mr. Schiavone asked if the designation would affect what was done "around that particular piece of land" more than the fact that it was in Sailboat Bend. Ms. Logan explained that this was in the historic district so adjacent parcels were already under that ordinance. The Code also indicated that the Historic Preservation Board could review new development of properties abutting a designated historic site.

Mr. Marcus remarked that Mr. Carr's report was excellent. (He asked if there were plans for an interpretive display on the site and Ms. Logan said the City planned to use it for a park but no plans had been submitted yet.) (Any plans for a new structure on the site would need to be presented to the HPB.)

Patricia Zeiler, Fort Lauderdale Historical Society, remarked that the site was extremely historically significant.

Motion made by Mr. Marcus, seconded by Ms. Sazera:

To recommend approval the request for Archaeological Site Designation of Rivermont located at 1016 Waverly Road to the City Commission under case number UDP-HPD20004 based on a finding this request meets criterion (a) as outlined in Section 47-24.11.C.7. of the ULDR. In a voice vote, motion **passed 7-0.**

Mr. Parker arrived at 5:25.

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Board members agreed to put a discussion item regarding the ordinance changes under Good of the City on their next gaenda. They would address this gaenda item first during the meeting.

Motion by Ms. Lynes, seconded by Mr. Schiavone, to include an agenda item reacrdina the Sailboat Bend Historic district updates under the Good of the City section of the Board's February 1 meeting. In a voice vote, motion passed 8.0.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 6:02 p.m.
