Please be advised that this correspondence shall serve as the City's Notice to Cure pursuant to Section 17.2 of Invitation to Bid No. 12292-296 (the "Agreement").

On February 15, 2021, Your firm met with Mr. Ben Rogers, Director of the Transportation and Mobility Department, and Mrs. Jodi Hart, Chief Procurement Officer regarding the finalization of the above referenced project. It was agreed by all parties at that time, that the project shall be completed by March 10, 2021 at 5:00 PM EST.

Further, the City hereby reserves all its rights and remedies pursuant to the Agreement and as otherwise provided, whether at law or in equity. Nothing contained herein shall operate as a waiver and/or limitation of any such rights or remedies afforded to the City, whether conferred by contract or otherwise by law.
