TITLE:	Resolution Approving a Joint Participation Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for Maintenance Services for the Historic CSX Railroad Bascule Bridge at River Oaks Preserve Area - \$100,000 - (Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) between the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City), in substantially the form attached, for the perpetual maintenance services for the historic CSX Railroad Bascule Bridge that FDOT has relocated at the River Oaks Preserve Area.

Background

The River Oaks Preserve Area consists of 9.1 acres of vacant land area that the City acquired to provide a solution to an existing flooding issue while providing a recreation preserve park for the residents. The City is in the process of constructing a passive stormwater park featuring freshwater wetlands, Florida native plantings, elevated boardwalk, an informational gazebo, and an historic CSX bascule bridge prepared for pedestrian access.

On July 10, 2012, the City entered into an agreement with FDOT to accept relocation of the historic CSX Railroad Bascule Bridge onto the River Oaks Preserve Area to be used as a pedestrian boardwalk, along with a one-time funding contribution from FDOT in the amount of \$100,000 for perpetual maintenance of the bridge.

On May 3, 2016, the City adopted a resolution ratifying a JPA between FDOT and the City to accept a one-time funding contribution from FDOT in the amount of \$100,000. However, the previous JPA expired prior to the one-time payment occurring. The current JPA will allow the City to accept the one-time funding contribution from FDOT for the perpetual maintenance of the historic CSX bascule bridge.

Resource Impact

There will be a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$100,000.
