TITLE: Motion Approving a Third Amendment to Subrecipient Agreement between

Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization and City of Fort Lauderdale Extending the Term to September 30, 2021 for the Downtown Fort

Lauderdale Mobility Hub Project - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a Third Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement, in substantially the form attached, between Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) and City of Fort Lauderdale and authorize execution of the Agreement to extend the term to September 30, 2021 for the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Mobility Hub Project ("project").

Background

The City and the BMPO entered into a Subrecipient Agreement ("agreement") on February 3, 2015, which approved the acceptance of a grant award of \$3,465,000 for Streetscape Improvements for the project (Exhibit 1), subject to the Federal Transit Administration's ("FTA") grant awarded to the BMPO.

The First Amendment of the Agreement, dated December 12, 2019, extended the term of the agreement to December 31, 2020. Due to unforeseen delays regarding the project, the City requested the approval of a Second Amendment to the agreement on December 2, 2020, which extended the contract term through April 27, 2021.

On March 16, 2021, City Commission approved a motion to terminate the contract with the existing contractor due to further delays and lack of completion of the project by the agreed upon due date. The Third Amendment (Exhibit 2) request is to extend the period of performance, to allow a new contractor to mobilize and complete the outstanding tasks the terminated contractor was unable to complete.

Resource Impact

This time extension will not result in any additional funds or costs to the City or the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization.
