TITLE:	Motion Approving Agreement for Sistrunk Parking Lot 19 Southeast Corner of NW 6th Street and NW 19th Avenue – National Concrete and Paving LLC- \$209,540 - (Commission District 3)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for Sistrunk Parking Lot 19 Southeast Corner of NW 6th Street and NW 19th Avenue with National Concrete and Paving LLC, in the amount of \$209,540.

Background

The proposed project is located at Sistrunk Boulevard and 19th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The work to be accomplished under proposed contract includes, but is not limited to, providing labor and material to construct a surface parking lot as per the drawings and specification given.

On January 14, 2021, the City of Fort Lauderdale issued Invitation to Bid No. 12491-113 Sistrunk Parking Lot 19 Southeast Corner of NW 6th Street and NW 19th Avenue. The City received fourteen bids in response to the solicitation which was opened on March 17,2021. The bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. National Concrete and Paving LLC was deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder. Three of the fourteen responding vendors have indicated their status as a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$209,540 for the contract award including the bid allowance. Funds for the contract award are available in the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Agency Fiscal Year 2021 Account listed below.
