| TITLE: | Broward County Solid Waste Working Group Update and Governance Structure Presentation - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4) |

On September 12, 2019, the City Commission approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Broward County confirming the City's desire to participate in a collaborative study and subsequent implementation of an integrated solid waste system (CAM 19-0670).

On November 5, 2019, the City appointed Commissioner Glassman as the City's primary representative to the Solid Waste Working Group (Working Group) with Commissioner Sorensen appointed as the alternate representative. Beginning February 2020, a series of meetings have been held to discuss operational needs for a Countywide solid waste system, its associated costs, and the governance structure most appropriate to support a regional solid waste system.

On March 1, 2021 the Working Group received a presentation on three potential governance structures and voted (6-3) that an Independent Special District structure be pursued. At the April 13, 2021 Working Group workshop, each participating community was asked to consider the adoption of an Independent Special District and to communicate their position at a meeting to be scheduled within 45 days.
