RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT AND AN ESCROW AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE POWDER-COATED TRAFFIC SIGNAL TROMBONE MAST ARM ASSEMBLIES AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROAD A1A AND SE 5TH STREET; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") performed an assessment of the trombone mast arms at the intersection of SR A1A and SE 5th Street and determined that the east bound mast arms need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, ("City") requested that the new mast arms match the color and finish of the existing mast arms along SR A1A, by powder-coating them in solar black; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has agreed to replace the mast arms with its standard trombone style product and will powder-coat the new assemblies solar black; and

WHEREAS, the City will be required to fund the solar black powder-coating on the mast arms at SR A1A and SE 5th Street through a Local Funding Agreement ("LFA") and Three Party Escrow Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and FDOT wish to execute the LFA in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Zero Cents (\$22,379.00) and execute an Escrow Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Locally Funded Agreement and an Escrow Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the powder-coated traffic signal trombone mast arm assemblies at the intersection of State Road A1A and 5th Street.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That all parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
