TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement and Music Exemption with The Heartbeat

Foundation Corp. for the 10th Anniversary Brazilian Festival on Fort

Lauderdale Beach - (Commission Districts 2 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an event agreement and request for extended hours for music, in substantially the form attached, with The Heartbeat Foundation Corp. for the 10th Anniversary Brazilian Festival on Fort Lauderdale Beach.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale welcomed the Brazilian Festival, formerly known as the Latino Festival, to Huizenga Park in December 2020. Staff was notified shortly after the success of the Latino Festival that the event would return in September 2021 for the 10th Anniversary.

The event organizer will pay for all event costs and submit the required certificates of insurances. The City is requiring the organizer to post an amount in escrow equal to 110% of the City's estimated service costs. The agreement provides that the organizer will pay \$500 per day for use of the beach. The organizer will also secure all other necessary permits and licenses that are required from other agencies. Civic and merchant associations have been notified as appropriate regarding events in their areas.

The applicant agrees to adhere to all COVID-19 guidelines and to follow CDC recommendations for a safe and successful event. In addition, applicant is required to obtain a turtle permit from the Department of Environmental Protection.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreement is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.

Effective October 1, 2015 the City began to enforce the noise requirements outlined in Exhibit 1.
