

RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$182,680.00, TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL YEAR OF FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE OPERATING COSTS OF THE DOWNTOWN LINK TRANSIT ROUTE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND TO ACCEPT SUCH ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING FOR FINANCIAL PROJECT NUMBER 434480-2-84-01; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, approved Resolution No. 20-79 to accept grant funds and execute a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to provide funding assistance for the operation of the Downtown Link transit route, in the amount of \$182,680; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the grant agreement will add one additional year of transit operating funds in the additional amount of One Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Eighty dollars and zero cents (\$182,680.00); and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement term end date will be extended to June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that authorizing the execution of the amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement and the acceptance of the additional grant funds is in the best interest of the City of Fort Lauderdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves an Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, with the Florida Department of Transportation, and to accept grant funding in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Eighty dollars and zero cents (\$182,680.00) to provide an additional year of funding assistance for the operating costs of the Downtown Link transit route for Financial Project Number 434480-2-84-01.

SECTION 3. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by proper City officials.

SECTION 4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
