Federal BSD, LLC - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road 5 (US 1) with the Florida Department of Transportation for landscape improvements within the right of way of State Road 5 (US 1) between Mile Post 0.64 to Mile Post 0.96 and an Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with 105 North Federal BSD, LLC.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") will enter into a Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement ("MMOA") with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements within the right-of-way on State Road 5 (US 1). The MMOA includes provisions allowing the property owner, 105 North Federal BSD, LLC, to construct additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement on State Road 5 (US 1) from Mile Post 0.64 to Mile Post 0.96, and in accordance with the plans attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" to the agreement. The Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement ("Agreement") between the City and 105 North Federal BSD, LLC, allocates the costs associated with the MMOA to 105 North Federal BSD, LLC. 105 North Federal BSD, LLC agrees to assume the City's obligation to maintain the improvements installed by them, in the right of way, in accordance with the Agreement.
