Motion Approving Minutes for May 4, 2021 Community Redevelopment Agency Board Meeting - (Commission Districts 2 and 3)

Commissioner Glassman made a motion to approve this item and was seconded by Commissioner Sorensen.

Motion Approving an Amendment to the Property and Business Investment Improvement Program Agreement for The Blue Tree Café, LLC, a Proposed Multi-Brand Virtual Kitchen and Restaurant at 612 NW 9th Avenue - (Commission District 2)

Executive Director Lagerbloom provided an overview of this item amending the forgivable loan to the *Blue Tree Café* business (forgivable loan) and impact on the property owner. He read negotiated terms of the forgivable loan and associated liens into the record.

1. The CRA will agree not to hold Property Owner in default in the event Blue Tree Café fails or ceases operation, so long as Property Owner is "actively" seeking a successor tenant. Satisfaction of Mortgage to be issued at the end of the term so long as Property Owner is actively seeking a successor. If a successor is found during the unexpired term and the successor

tenant signs a lease and signs an assumption of liability in favor of the CRA, then Property Owner would be in compliance.

- 2. Property Owner will agree to subordinate his Landlord's Lien.
- 3. The CRA will file a UCC-1 Financing Statement with the Secretary of State.
- 4. If default by Blue Tree Cafe, the CRA, at its election, can seek to recover possession of assets funded by the CRA.
- 5. During recovery of property, the CRA will compensate Property Owner for any damage caused by the CRA during the course of recovery. The CRA will not seek to recover any assets which are permanently affixed to the building.

In response to Chair Trantalis' questions, Lynn Solomon, Assistant City Attorney III - Office of the City Attorney, explained details associated with this item and confirmed the property owner has agreed to place a second mortgage on the property subject to the business loan terms read into the record by Executive Director Lagerbloom. She said the property owner and business owner are separate entities. There is an existing mortgage on the property and the City is taking a second position. Comment and discussion ensued.

Chair Trantalis commented on his perspective and concern regarding potential risk to the City.

Commissioner Glassman made a motion to approve this item as amended and was seconded by Commissioner Sorensen.
