TITLE: Motion Approving a Parking Space Use Agreement with CTS Engines, LLC

for Parking Spaces at SW 2nd Avenue, between SW 30th and SW 32nd Street

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to execute a five (5) year, parking space use agreement with an effective date of July 1, 2021, in substantially the form attached, with the CTS Engines, LLC., for 27 parking spaces located at SW 2nd Avenue, between SW 30th and SW 32nd Street.

Background

CTS Engines, LLC offers jet engine maintenance by providing repair, annual maintenance, overhaul, and testing services to owners and operators of early-stage commercial jet engines.

As part of their operational needs, CTS Engines, LLC leased parking spaces in the onstreet parking median area across from their operating address located at 3060 SW 2nd Avenue to park employee vehicles. A Temporary Vehicle Parking Agreement was entered into for a period of one-year, beginning on July 1, 2020, and ending on June 30, 2021.

This proposed parking space use agreement will contain the same business terms as the previous agreement. CTS Engines, LLC shall pay \$50.00 plus tax, per month, per space for utilizing 27 spaces 7 days a week 24 hours a day.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the Parking Fund in the amount of \$4,050 for FY2021 associated with this action. In future years, staff anticipates a positive annual impact in the amount of \$16,200.
