TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement with Florida Department of
Transportation (FDOT) for Maintenance and Operation of Lighting -
(**Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4**)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion for an agreement with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for maintenance and operation of lighting.

Background

FDOT has identified sites where lighting and/or lighting systems are located on the State Highway System within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Fort Lauderdale. Pursuant to the agreement, the City of Fort Lauderdale will maintain lighting for roadways, as well as park and ride, pedestrian overpasses, and recreational areas owned or located on the property of FDOT. The City will be compensated by FDOT for maintenance of these facilities, which include 2,513 lights, annually for a total amount of \$776,768.30.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.
