Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road A1A with the Florida Department of Transportation for Improvements within the Right-of-

Way of State Road A1A - (Commission District 2)

## **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Sixteenth Amendment to the Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) for State Road A1A with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for improvements within the right of way of State Road A1A (Fort Lauderdale Beach Boulevard) between Mile Post 2.736 to Mile Post 2.784 and State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) between Mile Post 0.673 to Mile Post 0.731.

#### **Background**

In January 2008, the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) entered into a Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements on various roads including State Road A1A. The Sixteenth Amendment includes provisions allowing the City to construct additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement on State Road A1A (Fort Lauderdale Beach Boulevard) from Mile Post 2.736 to Mile Post 2.784 and State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) between Mile Post 0.673 to Mile Post 0.731, and in accordance with the plans attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" to the agreement. The described landscape improvements and attached plans are part of the City of Fort Lauderdale's Community Redevelopment Agency Project 12373 at DC Alexander Park. Approval of this resolution will allow the proposed landscape improvements to be constructed and maintained by the City of Fort Lauderdale.
