**TITLE:** Motion Approving the Acceptance of 2021 PeopleForBikes Foundation -  
Better Bike Share Partnership Mini-Grant – \$10,000 - **(Commission  
Districts 2 and 3)**

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission authorize the City Manager to execute the Grant Agreement, in substantially the form attached, and approve the acceptance of the grant funds on behalf of the City for funding the Bike-N-Ride pilot program.

**Background**

The City was awarded a grant, on May 17, 2021, in the amount of \$10,000 from PeopleForBikes Foundation, with no match requirement, to launch a Bike-N-Ride pilot program. The pilot program will host three storytelling-infused art bike tours in the City's Northwest-Progresso-Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area. The tours will be held on the last Saturday of each month from July 2021 to September 2021. The tours will be open to the public and will be heavily marketed towards transit riders and users of social service facilities along the City's transit routes.

The City's Transportation and Mobility Department will lead the program efforts with support from two service providers, Broward B-Cycle and Choose 954. Broward B-Cycle is the shared bicycle operator in Broward County. They are a part of the Broward County transportation network and serve as their contracted vendor for bicycle sharing. Currently they are the only bike sharing provider in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Bike-Sharing is critical component of grant purpose. Choose 954 is a community organization within the city, they have experience in leading bike tours and critical mass bike rides across the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County. Choose 954 has specifically lead bike tours in the Northwest CRA.

**Resource Impact**

This action will result in a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$10,000, which will be appropriated to the accounts below contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 21-0096.
