TITLE: Resolution Approving an Application for a Dock Permit for Usage of Public
Property by Gex F. & Jamie G. Richardson Located at 1009 Cordova
Road - **(Commission District 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property for Gex F. & Jamie G. Richardson located at 1009 Cordova Road, Fort Lauderdale, FL.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the installation, use, maintenance and repair of a proposed 40-foot long x 10-foot wide floating dock, extending a maximum distance of +/- 12-feet from the wet face of the seawall on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 1009 Cordova Road, together with appurtenant two (2) 5-foot x 14-foot gangways, a 5-foot x 12.6-foot platform and two (2) 12-inch x 12-inch concrete pilings. Per Resolution 19-205, the \$1500 fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by private persons of public is waived for property owners whose seawalls were removed by the City due to the seawall construction project on Cordova Road.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval 13 to 0 of the application (see Exhibit 3).

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact related to this item.
