TITLE:	Public Hearing - Resolution Granting a Waiver of Limitations at 9 Hendricks Isle, for the Installation of a 24,000-pound Four (4) Post Boat Lift – (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution, pursuant to Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) 19.3(e), granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of a 24,000-pound four (4) post boat lift located at 9 Hendricks Isle.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring structures to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (C) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of a 24,000-pound four (4) post boat lift extending a maximum of +/-43.4 feet from the property line into Lago Karen.

The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed boat lift is necessary to protect the owner's vessel during high wind events and severe weather, as well as to allow for light penetration and natural resource protection.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$1500.00 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval of the application 13 to 0 (see Exhibit 3) at the June 3, 2021 meeting.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$1,500. Revenue related to the application fee is included in the FY2021 Operating Budget in the account listed below.
