Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the settlement of the general liability claim in the matter of James Smith v. City of Fort Lauderdale, et al. Case No. CACE 19-004547 (03) in the amount of \$157,500.

Background

James Smith filed a general liability claim and lawsuit against the City resulting from an injury on January 31, 2018. This injury occurred from his motorcycle striking a roadway depression caused by a City pipe failure near Cypress Creek Road (NW 62nd Street) and NW 21st Avenue. Litigation of this claim commenced on February 28, 2019 and after evaluation of the potential financial exposure to the City it was determined that a settlement would provide the most cost-effective outcome.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$157,500 subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$157,500.
