Submerged Lands Easement with the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida – Bill Keith Preserve –

(Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission authorize execution of the Renewal of the Sovereignty Submerged Lands Easement Agreement between the Board of Trustees and the City of Fort Lauderdale to continue the use of the sovereignty lands located at the Bill Keith Preserve for a ten-year renewal period starting July 18, 2021, through July 18, 2031.

Background

The Bill Keith Preserve, a City of Fort Lauderdale owned property, has been subject to erosion along the North Fork of the New River. As a response to stop the erosion and rebuild the shoreline, staff installed and placed into service submerged breakwaters (rock boulders) into the riverbed along the shoreline of the preserve in 2011. To execute the described project, the City was granted the use of a Sovereign Submerged Lands Easement for a period of ten years. This easement has expired and renewal for an additional ten-year period is desired.

Resource Impact

There is a no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.
