A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF BROWARD COUNTY POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE ON THE WESTBOUND LANE OF SOUTHWEST 1ST STREET AT SOUTHWEST 7TH AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale staff received a neighborhood request for the existing "No Thru Trucks" sign to be replaced due to the hazardous condition of the sign on the westbound lane of Southwest 1st Street at Southwest 7th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, during a site inspection, Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) determined the leaning sign to be hazardous to pedestrians and vehicular traffic and was removed; and

WHEREAS, City Traffic Engineering staff recommends the installation of a "No Thru Trucks" sign on the westbound lane of Southwest 1st Street at Southwest 7th Avenue to enhance public safety in that residential area; and

WHEREAS, a formal resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is required by Broward County for the new signage to be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby supports the installation of "No Thru Trucks" signage on the westbound lane of Southwest 1st Street at Southwest 7th Avenue, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in order to enhance public safety in the residential community.
